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(74) NAME OF ALLAH AL-MUBEEN

- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) made Himself clear to us; no one can be clearer than Allah (سبحانه وتعالى). No one is worthy of worship except Allah (سبحانه). No one is more Generous, more Powerful, no one can see and hear like Him, and no one has the knowledge like Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
- When you go to the beach, you see lots of sand there. Can you grasp and count all the grains of sand? No, never. But Allah (سبحانه) can. He knows which grains of sand are stuck in your shoes and tires and car mats when you go back to your car.
- Here we are just looking at one particular beach, imagine if we were to talk about all

the sands of the world. Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) knows the whereabouts of all the grains of sand - He knows where it will fly, and which color it will turn in - Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) has the full knowledge of everything. We cannot see all the leaves of a tree, and we cannot see all the details of a building, but Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) knows and sees.

What would you think if somebody gave birth to a child and then abandoned it? Of course, that is unfair. Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) created us all but never left us alone in this life. Allah (سبحانه) made clear for us the purpose of our life. He gave us clear guidance and made clear for us the identity of being a Muslim.

- We have knowledge of the pillars of Islam, and they are like the rocks in our life. Let's look at them.
- The first pillar of Islam is Shahadatain, which means to testify that there is no one worthy of worship except Allah ("") and Muhammad ("") is the Messenger of Allah. Imagine what will happen in the house if the mother is not there, or in a classroom if a teacher is absent? It will be full of chaos and confusion. Nothing will be clear.
- We need clear knowledge and guidance. We can't keep searching all the time for what needs to be done, what is the process, and so on. Alhamdulillah, Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) gave us this in our religion. We know exactly how to

- pray, how to pay zakat, how to fast in the month of Ramadan, and how to perform Hajj.
- We also know the pillars of Emaan. There are six: Belief in Allah, Belief in the Angels, Belief in the Books, Belief in the Messengers, Belief in the Last Day, and Belief in the Decree (good and bad).
- Can we say we just know it and that's it? No, we have to believe in it.
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) decreed everything for us, all the situations in our life Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) decreed our parents for us, everything is for us to become a better person, to become suitable for Jannah and return back to Him.
- Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) made the angels clear for us. We know they are made of light and they are obedient to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and they

are assigned tasks. For example, there are angels of study circles, angel Mikaeel who is in charge of the rain, and Israfeel who will blow into the Trumpet. We also know that angels don't like bad smells. They don't like the smell of garlic and onion, and they don't come close to these people, so we have to clean our mouths after eating it. Also, we know angels don't like loud noises. We don't want to drive the angels away from us, and that's why we should behave well so that they stay with us. We also know from their description they have different quantities of wings - some have 2, some have 3, and some even 600 wings. Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) made some angels the guardians of the sky, angels shoot the shayateen when they try to come up and

- listen to the news in the heavens, and hence we can see the falling stars.
- On the Day of Judgement, people will go to different Prophets and request them intercede for them. They will go to big Prophets one by one till they reach the Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ). And Allah (سبحانه) (ﷺ) will allow the Prophet Muhammad (وتعالى to start the Day of Judgement and will give him the intercession and then the Prophet Muhammad (*) will make only one dua: االله (سبحانه وتعالى) Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) will grant him this and allow 70,000 people to enter Paradise without any reckoning or punishment.
- We don't want to live in this life by just going where the wind takes us, no, we want to live

life with knowledge, while knowing where we are going and what we are doing. So we clarity in our life. Clarity is very need important. Imagine your small brother comes to you and asks you to follow him as he wants to show you something exciting. He is talking too many things about it, but there is no clarity, all confusing sentences. You feel like you want to know exactly what he is talking about, and you just want to make it clear after he has been talking for so long, so you follow him and then you come to know he was talking about a bird.

The same way you want the prayer to be prayed correctly and you want to know exactly how to perform it in the right way.

Alhamdulillah, Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) made it clear

for us through the sunnah of the Prophet Muhammad (*). We know how to perform wudhu and which du'a to make after the wudhu, and we know the direction of the gibla. We know how to cover ourselves and then we perform the prayer in a certain manner while knowing how many rakats to perform for each prayer. This is the clarity and mercy of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) on us. We ask Allah to make everything He loves clear (سبحانه وتعالى) to us. We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) to make us clear in our intentions, in our speech, in our expressions. May Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) make us firm on Islam, on the path of knowledge, regardless of where we were born – we want always to choose the religion of Islam over everything else.

- There are 3 questions in the grave: Who is your Rabb, What is your religion, Who is your Prophet? We have to learn these questions now to be able to answer them in the grave later.
- When we learn the Seerah of the Prophet (*), we know how to behave and react in our life. When he (*) got the revelation, he went to share it with the closest people to him starting from his immediate family. The Prophet (*) wanted to share his knowledge with the people out of love for them. Similarly, when we love someone, we want to share what we have learned with them, be it a new recipe or a shortcut for doing something, etc.
- Nowadays, we see lots of people not respecting their parents and ignoring them,

but at the same time, we see teenagers helping old people to cross the road or helping them to find their place to sit and they even do extra for them by serving them tea unexpectedly. This is the way Islam teaches us. We have to show goodness always as this is the way of Muslims. Just imagine when somebody else sees it, maybe a non-muslim, it will have an effect on him. سبحانه) This is the Muslim identity, may Allah always make us beautiful examples to inspire others. Ameen.
